Safety Spotlight

Regulator Safety Recommendation

To maintain the proper, pre-selected pressure in an airline, an air regulator valve should be used. However, some users want to use air valves to regulate water pressure. This should not be done. When an air valve regulator reduces outlet line pressure, that pressure is relieved through a port in the regulator. If an air regulator were used in a water application, the water would leak out through the relief port causing at least a mess, and possibly a serious safety hazard. Always use the right Dixon part for the right job.

Also, always use a locking air shut-off valve before a regulator so that the air pressure can be locked-out during service, maintenance and repair. Lockout / Tag-out procedures are an important part of an effective Safety Program. Be Safe.

Lubricator Safety Recommendation

Dixon airline lubricators are available with a heavy-duty transparent bowl with a bowl guard or metal bowl reservoir. Aluminum bowls offer greater protection against bowl damage while still allowing the oil level to be checked via a sight glass. All transparent bowls should be used with bowl guard properly installed. It protects the equipment that extends your equipment's life.

FRL Bracket Safety Recommendation

There is not much sense in spending the money to incorporate pneumatic preparation units (FRL's) into an air system if they aren't going to be properly supported. Unsupported units eventually cause leaks within the piping system that later become safety and efficiency problems. Please use the mounting brackets offered in the Dixon catalog. Everyone wins.

Liquid Filled Gauge Safety Recommendation

For a liquid filled gauge to properly function, the fluid level must be maintained at 90% capacity. Since gauges come with instructions for maintenance refills, please keep your eyes on the fluid level. You lose efficiency when you don't.
